Job brief

We are looking for online bilingual marriage prep instructors to mentor engaged couples in the ways of a Christ-centered marriage along the guidelines set forth by the Catholic Church. This ministry is an opportunity to reach out to the newly engaged and pass on the beautiful facets of the Catholic faith.

The goal is to help the newly engaged build a Christ-centered marriage, and for many to help foster a deep conversion. Instructors will get the couples to think and discuss each topic together first, in order for them to find their own answers. This heuristic process allows them to stay engaged in the subjects being discussed and helps them own the knowledge that is being passed on.

The instructor couple reviews each worksheet the engaged couple submits and uploads a personal answer key back to them. These answer keys will then complete the couple's answers with the teachings of the Church in a customized way. Instructors will ensure excellent interaction with the engaged couples, great service standards and maintain high customer satisfaction.

Responsibilities

- Build a relationship of trust with each engaged couple on an individual basis.
- Guide engaged couples to understand and follow the teachings of the Catholic Church.
- Review the engaged couples' worksheets, and respond back to them with a personalized answer within 24 hours to a maximum of three business days.
- Mentor the engaged couples through the Marriage Prep Program, answer their questions and share personal marriage experiences with them.
- Work in close contact with the Agape Instructor Coordinator.
- Attend a quarterly webinar meeting with the Instructor Coordinator and other instructors.

Requirements

- Instructor Couples must be practicing Catholics in good standing with the Church.
- In agreement with the Teachings of the Catholic Church, especially regarding Humanae Vitae, abstinence before marriage and openness to life.
- Be knowledgeable about Pope St. John Paul II's Theology of the Body, or ready to learn.
- Married at least five years.
- Both Catholics at least five years.
- Practicing NFP, or having practiced NFP.
- Excellent communication and self-presentation skills.
- Strong grasp of English and Spanish language and grammar in order to write comprehensive answers with no typos or errors.
- Familiarity with Agape Catholic Ministries systems and practices after training period.
- Self-motivated, self-disciplined, willing to ask for help when necessary.
- Organized, thorough.
- Bilingual in English and Spanish.
- Resident of Colorado is a plus but not necessary.

Training

- The Instructor Couple, husband and wife, have to do the training together.
- The whole training will be done online and by phone in a seven weeks period.
- Meeting in person for the Colorado Front Range is possible.
- After an agreement has been signed, the training can start.
- Once the training is completed, the Instructor Couple will be responsible for each engaged couple assigned to them and will contact the Instructor Coordinator directly with any questions or challenges that they might encounter.

Time requirement and Compensation

- Part-time, flexible hours, work from home.
- The Instructor Couple has 24 hours to a maximum of three business days to answer back to the engaged couples.
- Competitive commission-based pay.
