We are looking for **Live** Class Instructor Couples to mentor engaged couples in a class setting **in the Archdiocese of Denver**, along the guidelines set forth by the Catholic Church.



The goal is to help the engaged couples build a Christ-centered marriage, and for many to help foster a deep conversion. Instructors will get the couples to think and discuss each topic together first, in order for them to find their own answers. This heuristic process will allow the couples to stay engaged in the subjects being discussed and will help them own the knowledge that is being passed on. Instructors will ensure excellent interaction with the engaged couples, great service standards and maintain high customer satisfaction.

## Responsibilities:

- Build a relationship of trust with engaged couple.
- Guide engaged couples to understand and follow the teachings of the Catholic Church.
- Mentor the engaged couples through the marriage prep program, answer their questions and share personal marriage experiences with them.

## Requirements:

- Instructor Couples must be practicing Catholics in good standing with the Church.
- In agreement with the Teachings of the Catholic Church, especially regarding Humanae Vitae, abstinence before marriage and openness to life.
- Be knowledgeable about St John Paul II Theology of the Body, or ready to learn.
- Married at least five years.
- Both Catholics at least five years.
- Open to life, either by the practice of NFP, or by full and continual openness.
- Excellent communication and self-presentation skills.
- Excellent presentation skills
- Like getting to know new people
- Have a desire to teach others
- Familiarity with Agape Catholic Ministries systems and practices after training period.
- Self-motivated, self-disciplined, willing to ask for help when necessary.
- Organized, thorough.
- Bilingual in English and Spanish or French is a plus but not necessary.
- Resident of Colorado



## Training:

- The Instructor Couple, husband and wife, have to do the training together.
- The Instructor couple will go through the CatholicMarriagePrep.com online training to become familiar with the course.
- The instructor couple will then be able to teach the live class. In Denver, the new instructor couple will be able to sit in a live class with another instructor couple to experience how it's done.
- The live class consists of 4 sessions/one per week. Each class is 2 1/2hours long.
- The instructor couple works to engage the engaged couples in the material. It is of benefit to share your own marriage experiences to help the couples feel a connection to you and the material and to build the trust.
